The Governor appointed this special eight-member advisory committee in 1969 to study the effects of DDT and other pesticides in Maryland in an effort to determine whether more rigid controls or even a complete prohibition of the chemicals used in pesticides is needed. The committee is to make its report by January 1970 together with its recommendations for any tighter controls needed to regulate the use of pesticides. The committee is also attempting to compile more data on the residual effects of pesticides on Maryland's people, wildlife, fish, livestock, and crops.
