The Department of State Planning was created by Chapter 155, Acts of 1969 as the successor to the State Planning Department, established by Chapter 543, Acts of 1959. The predecessor agency had, in turn, replaced the Maryland State Planning Commission established by Chapter 39, Acts of the Special Session of 1933. The head of the Department is the Secretary of State Planning, appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.

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The Department of State Planning functions as the Governor's staff agency in planning matters, and prepares, recommends and keeps up-to-date a balanced integrated program for the development and effective employment of the natural and other resources of the State, in order to promote the health, safety and general welfare of its citizens.
