## PRIMARY ELECTIONS

By Chapter 560, Acts of 1969, the date of holding the primary elections by the political parties was changed to the second Tuesday after the first Monday in September for candidates for State offices and the State Central Committees. For elections by each political party in which national conventions are to be held for the nomination of President and Vice President, elections are to be held the third Tuesday in May (Code 1957, 1967 Repl. Vol., 1969 Supp., Art. 33, sec. 5-2).
