

ADDENDA AND ERRATA

It will be obvious to every reader of the MARYLAND MANUAL that a book of this size, scope and magnitude can never be wholly accurate even on the date it appears. The very last changes were made in proof late in December of 1973. But at that time, while to the best of our knowledge the book was believed to be accurate as of that date, other parts of the book, for example the section dealing with the General Assembly, are felt to be accurate only through November 15, 1973. In addition, the Legislative section may still be subjected to revision by the Courts. The final boundaries of the legislative districts for the election of the members of the General Assembly for the 1974 elections have not as yet been completely determined. The map with the description of these districts is based upon the plan submitted by the Governor in January of 1973. Both of these at press time do not reflect the possible changes which may be made in the near future by the Court of Appeals. Further, the suit challenging the election of the Chairman of the Republican State Central Committee of Maryland has not as yet been heard. Finally, the names of individuals and the State agencies represented in this addenda section have not been indexed with the rest of the book. The reader of the following will please take these facts into consideration.
