**Chapter 713—Acts of 1972**  
(House Bill 868)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 182 of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 edition), title "Queen Anne's County," subtitle "County Commissioners," as last amended by Chapter 310 of the Acts of 1955, to increase the number of County Commissioners to five and to provide for their qualifications as to residence, the manner of their election, and the manner of filling vacancies, and this act shall be subject to Local Referendum and generally relating thereto.
