The Center provides a program of basic and applied interdisciplinary research in mental illness and mental retardation. It also coordinates research activities at the various State mental hospitals, and offers training in research for graduate and post-graduate students in psychiatry and behavioral sciences (Code 1957, 1972 Repl. Vol., Art. 59, secs. 19C and 19D).
