This program was developed in anticipation of the Community Mental Health Center which is being constructed adjacent to the University of Maryland Hospital in Baltimore. In 1967 the Center began offering comprehensive community mental health services to all residents of a designated area in Baltimore City. These services include inpatient, outpatient, partial hospitalization, emergency and consultation education.

The Center presently maintains three outpatient satellites which provide care for adults, adolescents, and children. Short term residential care is available through an agreement with the University of Maryland's Institute of Psychiatry and Human Behavior. Psychiatric emergency service is available to area residents twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. Partial hospitalization services are offered five days a week. Consultation and education services are provided to agencies and other caregivers including police, courts, schools, housing projects, juvenile services and day care centers, etc.
