<sup>6</sup> Created by Chapter 205, Acts of 1976. The Commission consists of seventeen members of whom five are appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of Allegany County. Two members are appointed by the members of the General Assembly who represent Allegany County; three are appointed by the Mayor and City Council of Cumberland; two are appointed by the City of Frostburg; and one each are appointed by the municipalities of Barton, Lonaconing, Luke, Midland and Westernport. The Commission selects its own officers and is scheduled to report prior to January 1, 1978.

<sup>7</sup> Consists of 5 members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners for indefinite terms (Ch. 841, Acts of 1963).

<sup>8</sup> Appointed by the Board of County Commissioners for 6-year terms (Ch. 440, Acts of 1957).

Two members must be residents of Cumberland, 1 a resident of Frostburg, 1 a resident of the Central Georges Creek area, 1 a resident of the Mount Savage area, 1 a resident of the Cresaptown-Belair-Rawlings area, 1 a resident of Westernport, 1 a resident of Flintstone-Oldtown, 1 a resident of La Vale, 1 a resident of the Eckhart-Clarysville area and 1 a resident of the Corrigansville-Ellerslie area (Ch. 507, Acts of 1971).
