¹⁷¹ To consist of 12 members appointed by the County Commissioners. Members include a County Commissioner, the Superintendent of Schools, the Director of Social Services, the Director of Employment Security, the Vocational Rehabilitation representative of the State Department of Education, the President of the St. Mary's County Association for Retarded Children, and 5 at-large members. The enumerated members serve ex officio, while the at-large members serve for 4-year terms. The Board elects its own officers and appoints the Director (Ch. 199, Acts of 1970).

¹⁷² Consists of 11 members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners from among the Catholic clergy, ministerial associations, board of education and County Bar Association for four-year terms (Ch. 714, Acts of 1976).

¹⁷³ Consists of seven members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners for three-year terms (Ch. 815, Acts of 1974).

¹⁷⁴ Consists of 11 members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners for 2-year terms. The Commission selects its own officers. The President of the Board of County Commissioners serves ex officio. The Director is appointed by the Commission (Ch. 533, Acts of 1957).

¹⁷⁵ Appointed by the Board of County Commissioners (Ch. 885, Acts of 1963).

¹⁷⁶ Consists of seven members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners for three-year terms. The Board of County Commissioners selects the Chairman (Ch. 154, Acts of 1972).

¹⁷⁷ Consists of five members consisting of two licensed master electricians of St. Mary's County selected from a list submitted by the Electrical Contractors Association, a member of the Board of County Commissioners, and two members selected to serve terms concurrent with the County Commissioners (Ch. 304, Acts of 1972).
