

**Defunct Departmental Agencies**

**ENERGY OFFICE**

Transferred from the Department of Natural Resources to the Department of Housing and Community Development in 1987 (Senate Bill no. 699).

**ENVIRONMENTAL RESEARCH GUIDANCE COMMITTEE**

The Committee formerly served as an advisory board to the Power Plant Research Program. In 1986, the Committee merged into the Science Advisory Board, which now serves the Program.

**EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PROGRAM**

Formerly under the Water Resources Administration, the Program was transferred to the Department of the Environment in 1987 (Senate Bill no. 671).

**OIL CONTROL PROGRAM**

Transferred in 1987 to the Department of the Environment (Senate Bill no. 671). The Program previously had been under the Water Resources Administration.

**ROSARYVILLE STATE PARK ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

Formerly an advisory body for the Capital Programs Administration, the Committee has been inactive since 1985.

**SENECA CREEK STATE PARK ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

The Committee has been inactive since 1985. It previously had served as an advisory body for the Capital Programs Administration.

**STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM**

Formerly under the Water Resources Administration, the Program was placed under the Department of the Environment in 1987 (Senate Bill no. 671).

**WESTERN MARYLAND POWER PLANT SITING STUDY ADVISORY GROUP**

Disbanded in 1985 when the Western Maryland power plant study was completed.
