The Maryland Higher Education Commission was created in 1988 to replace the State Board for Higher Education and implement a reorganization of Maryland universities and colleges (Chapter 246, Acts of 1988).

State goals for higher education are set forth in the Maryland Charter for Higher Education adopted in 1988 (Code Education Article, secs. 10-201 through 10-212). The Commission, in consultation with the governing boards and agencies concerned with higher education, develops and

updates an overall plan, consistent with the Charter, to coordinate the growth and development of postsecondary education in Maryland.

Appointed by the Governor, the Secretary of Higher Education oversees the State's system of higher education.

The Commission has twelve members. Eleven are appointed to five-year terms by the Governor with Senate advice and consent. The chairperson of the Commission's Student Advisory Council serves in a nonvoting capacity as the twelfth member. The Governor designates the chairperson of the Commission (Code Education Article, secs. 11-101 through 11-206).
