The curriculum, class schedules, registration procedures, and comprehensive student services all have been designed to create an academic environment that supports and encourages the educational goals of working adults.

Evening and weekend classes meet at more than 25 locations throughout Maryland, the District of Columbia, and Virginia. The European and Asian divisions conduct degree programs for U.S. military personnel and their families at over 200 locations in twenty-two countries.
