

FISH, HERITAGE, & WILDLIFE ADMINISTRATION
Reorganized in 1995 as the Forest, Wildlife and Heritage Service.

GRANTS & RESOURCE ADMINISTRATION
Formerly under the Fish, Heritage, and Wildlife Administration, renamed Revenue Management and placed directly under the Resource Management Service in 1995.

GREENWAYS & RESOURCE PLANNING
Under the Land and Water Conservation Service, renamed Resource Planning in 1995.

INTERAGENCY COORDINATION
Formerly under the Fish, Heritage and Wildlife Administration, abolished in 1995 reorganization.

LAND ENHANCEMENT SERVICES
In 1995, renamed Land and Water Conservation Service.

LICENSING & WATERCRAFT REGISTRATION SERVICE
Formerly under the Deputy Secretary, reorganized as the Licensing and Registration Service in 1995 and placed under the Resource Management Service.

MARINE FACILITIES DEVELOPMENT
Formerly under Boating Administration, dissolved in 1995. Its functions were dispersed to the Land and Water Conservation Service.

MARYLAND NONGAME & ENDANGERED SPECIES CONSERVATION ACT TASK FORCE
Formerly under the Natural Heritage Program of the Fish, Heritage, and Wildlife Administration, the Task Force submitted its final report in December 1994.

NATURAL HERITAGE PROGRAM
Under the Forest, Wildlife and Heritage Service, the Program was reorganized in 1996 first as the Wildlife Diversity and Heritage Program and then as Heritage and Biodiversity Conservation Programs.

NATURAL RESOURCE IMPACT ASSESSMENT PROGRAM
Formerly under the Coastal and Watershed Resources Division, Program functions moved to the Watershed Management and Analysis Division in 1995.

NAVIGATION DIVISION
Formerly under the Boating Administration, dissolved in 1995. Some of its functions were reassigned to the Natural Resources Police Force.

PARK ADVISORY COMMISSION
Inactive since 1990.

PLANNING & POLICY PROGRAM
Formerly under the Boating Administration, renamed Boating Management and Waterway Planning in March 1995, then moved to the Chesapeake and Coastal Watershed Service and renamed Waterway Resources in November 1995.

POWER PLANT & ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW DIVISION
Formerly under the Tidewater Administration, the Division was renamed Power Plant Assessment Program and placed under the Resource Assessment Service in 1995.

PUBLIC FACILITIES DEVELOPMENT DIVISION
Formerly under the Boating Administration, dissolved in 1995. Its functions were dispersed to Engineering and Construction, and Program Open Space.

PUBLIC LANDS & FORESTRY
Reorganized in 1995 as Public Lands.

RESOURCE MANAGEMENT
Renamed the Resource Management Service in 1995.

SCIENCE ADVISORY BOARD
Formerly under the Monitoring and Nontidal Assessment Division of the Resource Assessment Service, the Board was disbanded in November 1995 due to budget reductions.

SHORE EROSION CONTROL PROGRAM
Formerly under the Boating Administration, dissolved in 1995. Its functions were reassigned to the State Forest and Park Service, and the Land and Water Conservation Service.

SPECIAL PROJECTS
Formerly under the Coastal and Watershed Resources Division, Special Projects functions were absorbed by the Geographic Information Services Division of the Chesapeake and Coastal Watershed Service in 1995.

STATE MAPPING COMMITTEE
Formerly under the Maryland Geological Survey, the Committee has been inactive since 1994.

TARGETED WATERSHEDS PROGRAM
Formerly under the Coastal and Watershed Resources Division, some Program functions were incorporated into the Watershed Restoration Division in 1995.

TIDEWATER ADMINISTRATION
Formerly under Resource Management, the Tidewater Administration was reorganized in 1995 first as the Resource Assessment Administration and then the Resource Assessment Service under Chesapeake Bay and Watershed Programs.

WATER RESOURCES ADMINISTRATION
Transferred to the Department of the Environment in 1995 (Chapter 488, Acts of 1995).

WATERFOWL ADVISORY COMMITTEE
Under the Wildlife Program of the Forest, Wildlife and Heritage Service, the Committee has been called the Migratory Waterfowl Advisory Committee since 1994.

WATERSHED IMPACT EVALUATION PROGRAM
Formerly under the Coastal and Watershed Resources Division, in 1995 some of its functions transferred to the Watershed Management and Analysis Division.

WATERWAY SERVICES
Formerly under the Boating Administration, dissolved in 1995. Its functions were reassigned to the Land and Water Conservation Service and the Licensing and Registration Service.
