The bill entitled an Act to refund to M. F. O'Neal the sum of fifty dollars erroneously paid into the Treasury of the State.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Claims.

The bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Salisbury Navigation Towing and Wharf Company.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Chesapeake Bay and its Tributaries.

The bill entitled an Act to increase the number of incorporators in an Act to incorporate the Westernport and Potomac Railroad Company, passed at the January session in eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter two hundred and nineteen.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 922, 924, 926 and 927, of Article four, of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the City of Baltimore, and to re-enact the same with amendments, subject, "Home of the Friendless."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Baltimore city delegation.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal an Act passed January session 1868, (chapter 104,) appropriating a sum of money to remove the Confederate dead to Antietam National Cemetery, and in lieu thereof to enact the following.
