

The question then recurring upon the adoption of the title, Mr. Hoblitzell submitted the following amendment :

Add after "Baltimore city : " in pursuance of the 40th section of the 4th Article of the Constitution.

The amendment was adopted, and the title, as amended, was then adopted.

The bill was then sent to the Senate.
