

Said bill was then sent to the Senate.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal section 58, as amended by chapter 348 of Acts passed 1868, and 60, of Article 16, of the Code of Public General Laws, under the title of "Chancery," sub-title "Jurisdiction," and to re-enact the same with amendments,
