Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal section 483, of Article 4, of the Public Local Laws, of the City of Baltimore, sub-title "Lumber,"

Was read a third time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The Secretary of the Senate returned the bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections 12 and 14, of Article 41, Code of Public General Laws, title "Fish and Fisheries," sub-title "Potomac," and to add additional sections thereto, for the further protection of fish, and regulation of the shad and herring fisheries in said river,

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendment.
