On motion of Mr. Baldwin, of Anne Arundel, (the rules being suspended,)

The House proceeded to the consideration of the bill entitled an Act to appropriate the sum of eight thousand one hundred and twenty-two dollars and twelve cents, to pay William Black, of Annapolis, and others, for the purchase money of the lot or lots of ground upon which the Governor's stable and carriage house in the City of Annapolis have been built, and for the work and labor done and materials furnished by said William Black and others in the erection of the same.
