Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the village of Mount Washington, in Baltimore county.

On motion of Mr. Brown,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Brown, Thomas and Hardcastle, of Talbot, to introduce a bill to provide for the protection of sheep in Queen Anne's county.

On motion of Mr. Neill,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the Antietam Railroad Company of Washington county, in the State of Maryland.

On motion of Mr. Harrington,

Leave was granted to the Dorchester county delegation to report a bill to change the number of election districts in Dorchester county, by annexing what is at present known as Holland's Island election district, No. 14, to Straight's district, No. 10, of said county.
