Mr. Martin, Chairman of a Select Committee, (the rules being suspended,) reported favorably,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal the 83d section, of the 20th Article, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled "Fish and Fisheries," in the Patuxent river, and to re-enact the same with amendments, with proposed amendments:

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Section 2, amend by inserting after the word "River," in the 3d line the following: below Queen Anne, in Prince George's county.

Amend by striking out all after the word "except" in line 3, section 2, down to the word "nor" line 6, same section, and insert in lieu thereof: *bona fide* citizens of the State of Maryland.
