Which was rejected.

Mr. Sanner submitted the following amendment:

Section 16, line 9, strike out the words "within two and a-half miles of," and insert: in waters less than fourteen feet in depth, on or about.

Which was adopted.

Mr. Kilbourn submitted the following amendment:

Section 21, line 8, strike out all after the word "provided" to the end of section.

Which was adopted.

Mr. Brattan submitted the following amendment:

Section 25, line 12, strike out all after the word "sureties" to the word "shall," in line 13.

Which was rejected.

Mr. Shipley submitted the following amendment:

Strike out section 33.

The question then recurring upon the adoption of the amendment.

Mr. McCreery moved the previous question.

The question then being "Shall the previous question be now put?"

It was decided in the affirmative.

The question then recurring upon the adoption of the amendment submitted by Mr. Shipley,

It was rejected.

Mr. Sanner submitted the following amendment:

Section 33, strike out all down to the word "and" in line 4.

Which was rejected.

Mr. Baldwin, of Anne Arundel, submitted the following amendments:

Section 33, line 8, add after the word "vessels," provided that the Board aforesaid, shall under no circumstances exceed the above appropriation.

Which was adopted.
