

The bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Montgomery county to add additional buildings to the almshouse of said county, and to levy a tax upon the assessable property of said county to pay for the same,

The bill entitled an Act providing for the erection of an additional Live Stock Scale, and appropriating a sum of money therefor,

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays."

The bill entitled an Act to amend the Act of 1868, chap. 138, relating to election districts in Charles county, by adding an additional section to said Act,

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

The bill entitled an Act to repeal section 10 of Article 5, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Appeals," and to insert in lieu thereof the following section,

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays."

The bill entitled an Act to add additional sections to the Code of Public Local Laws for Charles county, under the head of "Roads,"

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays."

The bill entitled an Act to amend certain portions of the Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Cecil and Harford counties Boom Company, passed at the January session of 1867, chapter 195, and to require the said company to remove certain and all obstructions placed by them in the Susquehanna River, in violation of the aforesaid Act,
