

And said bill recommitted to the Committee on Wild Fowl.

The Secretary of the Senate returned the following bills :

The bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 164, 165, 167 and 169 of an Act passed January session, 1868, chapter 87, entitled an Act to add additional sections to Article 11, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Frederick county, relating to the powers and duties of the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick, to follow section 161, and to substitute, in lieu of sections 164, 165, 167 and 169, the following,
