On motion of Mr. Gorman,

The vote by which the bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 555, 557, 558, 559, 560, 561, 562, 563, 564, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore city, entitled "Wood," and also to repeal chapter 116, passed January session, 1862, relating to inspection and cording of fire wood in Baltimore city,
