The Secretary of the Senate returned the following bills:

The bill entitled an Act to appropriate the sum of sixty-nine thousand two hundred and ninety-six dollars and twenty-eight cents, to pay the various mechanics and others the amounts due them for work and labor done and materials furnished in the erection of the Governor's Mansion at Annapolis, and the enclosure and improvement of the grounds surrounding the same,
