AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Section 3, strike out "first of January," and insert in lieu thereof the first of May.

Amend title by striking out "470," and inserting 477, and at the end of the title add: and sections 495 to 547 inclusive, relating to tobacco.

Amend section 1, line 16, by striking out "470," and inserting 477.

Section 1, line 16, amend by adding after the word "inclusive," the words: and sections 495 to 547 inclusive, relating to tobacco.

Amend by adding at the end of the second section: except such as relates to the weighing of hay and straw to the Weigher of Live Stock and Inspection of Tobacco.
