

Said bill was then returned to the Senate.

The bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claims of Jacob and Henry Crane, Nathan Masters, Daniel Caulk, James E. Tate, James Revell, F. Raine, John Murphy & Co., Wm. Lockerman, Elijah Towers, Bartlett Robbins & Co., Charles A. Wailes, Samuel Stewart and Samuel Davis,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 171 and 172, of Article 16, Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's county, title "Sheriffs," and to re-enact section 171, of the same.

Was read a third time,

And, on motion of Mr. Marbury,

The enacting clause was stricken out.

The Senate bill entitled an Act for the the more strict compliance of the State of Maryland with the provisions of an Act of Congress, approved July 2nd, 1862, entitled an Act donating public lands to the several Territories which may provide for the benefit of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts,

Was read a third time and rejected by yeas and nays, as follows:
