Leave was granted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to introduce a bill to repeal section 9, Article 28, Code of Public General Laws authorizing the County Commissioners of the several counties to publish a statement of the county expenses and re-enact the same with amendments.

On motion by Mr. Maddox,

Leave was granted Senators Maddox, Earle and Welch to introduce a bill to establish the office of wood corder for Leonardtown District in St. Mary's county.

On motion by Mr. Carroll,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to introduce a bill to remedy and give effect to informal and invalid deeds and quiet possession thereunder.

On motion by Mr. Spates,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to report a bill increasing the per diem and mileage of the County Commissioners of Allegany county.
