dred and sixty-nine, the same to be reported in parallel columns, which shall show the name of each pensioner, the amount paid to each for each year; the aggregate amount disbursed in pensions each year, and the name of the county or Legislative District of the City of Baltimore in which each pensioner resides."

I herewith transmit a statement, showing the names enrolled from each county and Baltimore City, under the Acts of 1867, chapter 385, and 1868, chapter 432, and the amounts paid to each on account of the calendar years of

1867, 1868 and 1869.
