FRIDAY, January 28, 1870.

The Senate met pursuant to adjournment.

Prayer by the Rev. Mr. Henderson.

Present at the roll call the following Senators :

Messrs. President, Biggs, Browne, Earle, Fields, Grove, Henry, Hyland, Jump, Malone, Miller, Sellman, Snyder, Spates, and Welch—15.

The Journal of Thursday was read and approved.

Mr. Snyder presented the petition of the Maryland College of Pharmacy, praying for a renewal and extension of their charter.

Which was read and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

On motion by Mr. Snyder,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to renew and extend the Act of Assembly incorporating the Maryland College of Pharmacy, passed at the December session, 1841, and which Act will expire by limitation in January, 1871.

On motion by Mr. Spates,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to report a bill to amend the Act of January session, 1867, chapter 268, entitled an Act to incorporate the Baltimore Warehouse Company.

On motion by Mr. Browne,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to introduce a bill to extend the time for collecting taxes to S. R. Gore, of Carroll county.
