Mr. Fields, from the Select Committee, to whom was referred House bill entitled, an Act to repeal sections 162, 163, 164, 165, 166, 167, 168, 169, 170 and 171, of Article 6, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Caroline County," sub-title "Roads," and to substitute therefor the following, reported it without amendment.

Said bill was then read the second time.

The Senate bill entitled, an Act to prevent incompetent persons from conducting the business of druggist or apothecary in the City of Baltimore,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to facilitate the examination of titles to lands in Prince George's county,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The Senate bill entitled, an Act to add a new section to the Code of Public Local Laws for Cecil county, under the title of "Schools," for the purpose of apportioning the Academic Fund of said county among the several Academies thereof,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Frederick county to build a new Almshouse for Frederick county; to borrow money on the credit of the county for that purpose; to issue bonds for the payment of the same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county to redeem said bonds, and to pay the interest thereon,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
