Leave was granted to Senators Malone, Henry and Fields, to introduce a bill to amend and revive an Act passed at December session, 1847, chapter 306, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Withers Mining Company."

Mr. Miller, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, to whom was referred the petition of Anthony Kimmel and other citizens of the village of New London, Frederick county, praying for the passage of a law to prohibit the sale of intoxicating drinks in said village, reported it unfavorably, and the report was adopted.

Mr. Miller, from the same Committee, reported unfavorably the Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal the 15th section of the 1st Article of the Code of Public Local Laws of Allegany county, as amended by the Act of 1864, chapter 164, relating to the mileage of the County Commissioners of Allegany county, and the report was adopted.

Mr. Miller, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, to whom was referred House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 170, of Article 30, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Rivers," reported it with the following amendment:

Which was adopted.
