The bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 1 and 2, of chapter 240, passed at the December session of the General Assembly, 1861, entitled an Act to amend Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the City of Baltimore, by imposing penalties for polluting the water in Swan Lake, the dam, reservoir, line of conduit, water pipes, gate house, or other works constructed or used in supplying the City of Baltimore with water, or injuring, defacing or destroying the same, and to re-enact the said sections so as to read as follows.

A bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Antietam Railroad Company in Washington county .

A bill entitled a supplement to an Act entitled an Act to incorporate a Company to build a Turnpike Road from Libertytown, Frederick county, through Johnsville to Ripe creek, passed January session, 1864, and its supplement, passed January session, 1868.

A bill entitled an Act to regulate the payment of the State's donation to Harford county Academy.

A bill entitled an Act authorizing the County Commissioners of Wicomico county, to appoint three Trustees for the Almshouse of said county.
