Said bill was then sent to the House of Delegates.

On motion by Mr. Maddox,

Leave of absence was granted to the Senator from Kent county until Tuesday next.

On motion by Mr. Hyland,

Leave of absence was granted to the Senator from Carroll county until Tuesday next.

On motion by Mr. Henry,

Leave of absence was granted to the Senator from Caroline until Thursday next.

Mr. Snyder moved that when the Senate adjourn it stand adjourned until Monday next, at 12 o'clock.

Mr. Spates called for the yeas and nays.

Upon the question being put it was determined in the negative:

On motion by Mr. Clarke,
