A bill entitled an Act to permit the hunting of foxes in Kent county.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Senators from Kent, Queen Anne's and Talbot counties.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal section 50, of Article 9, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Charles county" sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables," and re-enact the following in lieu thereof.
