

The Senate bill entitled an Act to direct the Comptroller to issue his warrant to pay George Colton & Son for the sum of \$2,495.47,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

On motion by Mr. Earle,

The vote by which said bill was ordered to be engrossed for a third reading,

Mr. Earle submitted the following amendment:

Amend by adding section 2, And be it enacted, that this Act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

Said bill, as amended, was then ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
