The vote by which the Joint Resolution authorizing the Comptroller to audit and adjust the claim of the State against W. G. Burke, late Sheriff, of Harford county, was ordered to be engrossed for a third reading,

Was reconsidered.

Mr. Earle submitted the following amendment:

Amend by adding at the end of Joint Resolution, that this Resolution shall go into effect after the date of its passage.

Which was adopted.

Said Resolution, as amended, was then ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
