A bill entitled an Act to add additional sections to the Act of 1865, chapter 36, entitled an Act to incorporate the German Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled an Act to relieve and protect minor operatives in the cotton and woolen factories in the State of Maryland.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 296 and 212, of Article 21, of the Public Local Laws of Washington county, and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add a subsection thereto.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Senators from Washington and Harford counties, and the first Legislative District of Baltimore city.

A bill entitled an act for the relief of Daniel Ammen, of Anne Arundel county, and authorizing the County Commissioners of said county to correct errors in his assessment.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Senators from Anne Arundel, Baltimore and Frederick counties.
