

Said bill was then returned to the House of Delegates.

The House bill entitled an Act to repeal sections from 98 to 113, both inclusive, of Article 6, of the Code of Public Local Laws, under the title of "Caroline County," sub-title "Greensborough," and the Act of 1866, chapter 96, and to enact the following in lieu thereof,
