House bill entitled an Act to amend chapter 389 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1864, entitled an Act supplemental to the Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Baltimore and Liberty Turnpike Company, &c., reported it without amendment.

Said bill was then read the second time.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to amend the 10th section of the Act of 1868, chapter 299, relating to the Public Roads, so as to include Wicomico county therein, and to make all the provisions of said Act apply to Wicomico county, so as to read as follows,
