#### JOINT RESOLUTIONS.

*Be it Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Attorney General is hereby directed to institute forthwith proper legal proceedings against the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad Company for the recovery of the sum which may be due to the State for the one-fifth of the whole amount received by the Company for the transportation of passengers on said railroad, under the provisions of the Act of Assembly of Maryland passed at December session, 1832, chapter 175, section 8, and of the Supplement thereto, and to press the same to a speedy and final determination.

*And be it further resolved,* That the Governor is hereby authorized to employ counsel to aid the Attorney General in the prosecution of the said proceedings.
