Mr. Crawford, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably a bill entitled an Act to empower the Commissioners of Wicomico county, to appoint an additional Constable in Sharptown district, No. 10, of said county.

Mr. Owens, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably a bill entitled an Act granting the assent of the General Assembly of Maryland to a bequest of a legacy made in the last will and testament of Elizabeth A. McMains, late of Cecil county, deceased, to the Trustees of the Lower West Nottingham Presbyterian church, in said county.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Cooper, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably a bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 958 and 959 of an Act entitled an Act to ratify the purchase and to provide for the organization and government of Druid Hill and Patterson Parks belonging to the city of Baltimore, by incorporating certain additional sections in Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws, passed January, 1862, and to re-enact the same with amendments.
