

Leave was granted to the Committee on Labor and Agriculture to report a bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 250, 251, 252, 253, 254, 255, 256, 257, 258, 259 and 260, of Article 4, Public Local Laws, sub-title "Foreign Passengers," and to re-enact the following in lieu thereof.

On motion by Mr. Snyder,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Maryland Commercial and Steamship Company of Baltimore, and more particularly to establish a line of Steamers and other vessels from Baltimore, in the State of Maryland, to Galveston, in the State of Texas, and other ports, and for other business purposes connected therewith.

Mr. Miller presented the petition of sundry citizens of Port Deposit, in Cecil county, relating to the town limits of Port Deposit.

Leave was granted to the Senators from Cecil, Carroll and Worcester counties to bring in a bill entitled an Act to repeal section 146, of Article 8, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Cecil County," and relating to the village of Port Deposit, and re-enact the same with amendments.

Mr. Biggs, from the Committee on Labor and Agriculture to whom the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 250 to 260, both inclusive, of Article 4, Code of Public Local Laws, sub-title "Foreign Passengers," and re-enact the following in lieu thereof.
