Said bill was then returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Clarke, from the Select Committee, to whom was re-committed House bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 149 to 157, of the 3d Article of the Public Local Laws, relating to Roads in Baltimore county, and sub-sections 2 to 7 inclusive, and section 3 of the Act of the General Assembly, chapter 411, approved March 30, 1868, and to enact the following sections in lieu thereof, reported with the following amendments :

Section 4, line 6, strike out the words "two thousand," and insert five hundred.

Amend 13th section by adding after the word "fund," in 7th line: and whenever there shall not be sufficient money in the County Treasury set apart as the special road and bridge fund of any district, the County Commissioners are hereby authorized to borrow upon the credit of the county, a sum of money not exceeding two thousand dollars, to meet the requirements of said district, and shall pay the same, together with the interest thereon, out of the special road fund set apart for said district.
