

On motion by Mr. Stephenson,

Leave was granted to the Senators from Harford and Dorchester counties, and the first legislative district of Baltimore city, to report a bill to protect the owners of lands bounding on the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries, from injury done by claimants of drift logs trespassing on said lands.

The House bill entitled an Act for the better protection of Fur in Dorchester and Wicomico counties,
