Mr. Spates, from the Select Committee to whom was referred House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Agricultural and Mechanical Society of Allegany county, West Virginia and Pennsylvania to issue coupon bonds and secure the payment, reported it without amendment.

Said bill was then read the second time.

The Senate bill entitled an Act for the better protection of Sheep, and to tax dogs in Baltimore county,

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
