A bill entitled an Act to authorize the Governor to appoint an additional Justice of the Peace for the 4th and 5th election districts of Montgomery county.

A bill entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Keedysville, in Washington county.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Senators from Washington and Harford counties, and the 1st Legislative District of Baltimore city.

A bill entitled an Act to regulate the trial fees of the State's Attorney for Kent county.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Senators from Kent, Queen Anne's and Somerset counties.

A bill entitled an Act to regulate and make uniform the compensation of the Judges of the Orphans' Courts of the several counties, and to fix the compensation of the Judges of the Orphans' Courts of Baltimore city, in pursuance of the 4th section of Article 4, of the Constitution.
