A bill entitled a supplement to an Act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland, at January session, 1868, chapter 424, entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Berlin, Worcester county.

A bill entitled an Act to amend an Act passed at January session, 1868, chapter 161, entitled an Act to incorporate the Frederick and Emmittsburg Railroad Company, extending said road and the time for commencement and completion of the same.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal section 2, of chapter 100, passed at the session of the General Assembly, 1867, entitled an Act to incorporate the Trustees of the Baptist Church, at Jones' Mill, in Dorchester county, and re-enact the said section so as to read as follows.

The bill entitled an Act to enlarge the corporate powers of the Maryland Baptist Union Association, in relation to the holding of property,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to amend an Act passed at the General Assembly of Maryland, in the year 1853, chapter 276, entitled an Act to incorporate the Maryland Mutual Life and Fire Insurance Company, by changing the corporate name thereof,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to enable certain alien heirs of William Dalzell, late of Montgomery county, deceased, to
