Said bill was then read the second time.

A bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the Trustees of the Lower West Nottingham Presbyterian Church, in Cecil county, or their successors, to receive by conveyance a lot of ground as an addition to the grove surrounding said church.

.Which was read the first time and referred to the Senators from Cecil, Worcester and Carroll counties.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal the Act passed 1864, entitled an Act to divide No. 10, or Straight's district, in Dorchester county.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Senators from Dorchester, Caroline and Wicomico counties.

A bill entitled an Act supplementary to an Act passed
