A bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 165, 166, 167, 168, 169, 170, 171, 173, 174 and 185, of Article 10, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Dorchester county, relating to roads, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Senators from Dorchester, Caroline and Wicomico counties.

The House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Governor to appoint an additional Justice of the Peace for Montgomery county,
